LIFE SAVING RULES.



FIT (FIT FOR DUTY)

Be prepared both mentally and physically in order to safely do the job every day.



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Use required PPE at all times.



FALLING

Block access into active falling areas.
Address danger trees concurrent with harvesting operations.
Follow TimberWest requirements and safe industry practices per WorkSafeBC and BCFT.



OPERATION OF VEHICLES + MOBILE EQUIPMENT

Wear seat belts when operating vehicles and mobile equipment.

Drive with care and attention.
Operate equipment on steep slopes in compliance to WorkSafeBC Steep Slope Regulations.

Always use 3-Point contact when climbing on / off equipment.



EQUIPMENT + SITE OPERATIONS

Do not knowingly render a safety device inoperable.

Operate and use tools and equipment for the purpose it is designed for.

Address and communicate all known hazards.

Follow working alone procedure.



WORKING AROUND PEOPLE + EQUIPMENT

Always be in the clear.

Maintain two tree length working distance from active falling or unaddressed danger trees.

Only perform maintenance on equipment that is adequately locked out.

Do not expose a worker to moving logs, rigging, equipment or other material.

Do not remove any wrappers from an unsecured load.

Comply with all WorkSafeBC blasting regulations.

Comply with all company guidelines and WorkSafeBC regulations when working near/under power-lines.
